EXCURSIONS

COCO/FELICITE/SISTER ISLANDS This exploration will light up your senses as you admire the water world of the Coco and Felicite islands that host this wonder as part of their attractions. Coco is located off the coast of La Digue Island and is renowned for its beautiful aquatic world. Neighboring Felicite was a coconut plantation up to the 1970s and up until recently, it was home to an up-market lodge offering exclusive island experiences. With the help of a snorkel, you can enjoy swimming with a variety of tropical fishes and then simply relax on a beautiful beach with a panoramic view of the nearby islands

ROBINSON CRUSOE ADVENTURE CRUISE This is a great adventure for those young hearts with the first stop being at St. Pierre Island, a favourite with swimmers and snorkelers. You will then visit Curieuse island reserve, where you can admire the giant land tortoises and enjoy a one hour tour of the island, walking through the mountains and mangroves swamp to Anse Josee. The day continues with a mouth-watering BBQ lunch, served aboard the elegant Oplezir catamaran, before cruising to the stunning Anse Georgette beach for a photo stop and a refreshing swim. The trip will end with a scenic cruise along the North East coast of Praslin Island.

2 ISLAND MELODY

An excellent choice for those wishing to get a little closer with Mother Nature, this excursion will take you to the breathtaking Valle de Mai on Praslin. The reserve is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is home to the famous Coco-de-mer and many endemic fauna species including the Seychelles Black Parrot. Then, with the help of a traditional schooner, you will be given a rare opportunity to see a traditional coprah mill and an old Plantation house at L'Union Estate on La Digue. Step foot on the soft, white sand of Anse Source d'Argent, reputed to be the most photographed beach in the world. The afternoon is all yours to relax on the beach.

FULL DAY DISCOVERY TOUR OF MAHE Begin with a tour of the capital, Victoria, and the picturesque charms of its ancient clock tower and colourful market, while our guides recount for you the history of the islands. After the market tour they will enchant you with tales of folklore as you journey on to the enchanting old Mission Lodge byway of a winding mountain road, where breathtaking panoramas of rambling tropical vegetation, towering granite peaks and the azure ocean await. Travel on for a delicate Creole lunch prepared from our succulent local fruits and vegetables. End your day in the traditional ambiance of the Craft Village where an inviting collection of arts, crafts and tropical wares are created.

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FULL DAY REEF SAFARI (including visit of Moyenne Island)

Start your journey with a gentle cruise past the reclaimed island of Hodoul, home to large numbers of herons and cattle egrets. Then motor out into the marine park where you will board our semi-submersible to keep your feet dry while exploring the teeming reefs. Hand the fish their breakfast before diving in for your own sub-marine adventure. We provide lightweight snorkeling vests and snorkeling equipment to allow you to get up close to the fascinating underwater world. Enjoy a mouth-watering buffet, prepared in the traditional Seychellois style and served on board the catamaran.. After lunch join us on the scenic route back to Port Victoria, with a leisurely cruise around the islands of the marine park.

FULL DAY PEAKS OF PARADISE – hike & cruise

An opportunity to experience a thrilling adventure trekking along Mahé's northern coast before cruising back to Victoria, aboard our catamaran "Anahita". Starting from "Danzilles", the palm-fringed trail along the deserted northwest coast follows the contours of ancient granite boulders.. The 1.5 hour walk ends at Anse Major, where 'Anahita' is moored in the sheltered bay. After boarding, the day's excursion continues with a cruise to Bay Ternay Marine Park, stopping at undisturbed snorkelling sites, where guests not wishing to swim can spend time feeding the fish or sunbathing on the spacious deck. Lunch is served on board before the gentle cruise home.

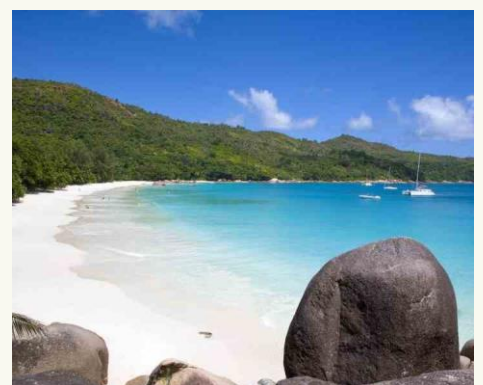

FULL DAY PRASLIN Discover the timeless charms of Seychelles' second largest island, home to the renowned Vallée de Mai, where the magnificent Coco-de-Mer, the world's heaviest nut, grows on ancient palms in a primeval forest once believed to be the original site of the Garden of Eden. Delve into this mysterious glade of towering palms, now a UNESCO World Heritage site, where the rare Seychelles Black parrot flits between unique species of endemic flora. From here we will introduce you to the island's most magnificent beach, Anse Lazio, where magnificent boulders grace silver sand slapped by clear turquoise waters – the perfect spot for a refreshing dip or just a lazy, tropical afternoon.

FULL DAY LA DIGUE ISLAND – Boat & bike

What a better way to explore the beauty of La Digue Island, one of Seychelles' most stunning granitic island – perhaps the most photographed in the world! With its stunning beaches and gigantic boulders cascading down the sea, La Digue is an experience not to be missed. The journey begins with a leisurely cruise across the channel that separates Praslin and La Digue Islands. Upon arrival at the picturesque La Passe harbour, a briefing on the places This mode of transport is ideal for you to discover the island at your own leisurely pace. As you pedal along, look out for the stunning Creole architecture, the coconut factory and other interesting sites all vivid reminders of the lifestyle of a bygone era.
